



**CIRCULAR WALK TO BARNSTONE LODGE**

DISTANCE: 4 ½ kms (2 ¾ miles)  
 TIME: 1 ¾ hours



1. On leaving the tearoom turn left along the road.
2. Go past Dove Cottage on your right hand side and when the road ends continue straight on along the bridleway. A hedgerow and wood will be on your left hand side and a yellow marker directly to your front in the distance. On reaching the marker continue straight ahead. A hedgerow will be on your right hand side. On reaching the tree line maintain walking in the same direction ignoring a second yellow marker in the corner of the field to your right. You should now be travelling on a concrete road, the old perimeter road of Langar Aerodrome. At the third marker post come off the

concrete path and go slightly right though keeping the hedge on your right hand side. Barnstone Lodge should be visible directly to your front.

3. Go through a small gate and turn left keeping the hedge on your left. After approximately 100 metres turn right along a track with a hedgerow either side.

4. On reaching the road turn right until you reach Barnstone Lodge. Follow the track around to the right which skirts the farm. Continue along the farm track ignoring any footpath signs to your right.

5. The farm track is bisected by the embankment of a disused railway. Turn right at this point travelling along the embankment.

6. A number of bridges traversing farm tracks are walked over. The fifth bridge (number 46) goes over the Grantham Canal. Five metres before this bridge a steep path to the right takes you off the embankment. At the bottom turn left and head through a gap in the hedge. You are now on the Grantham Canal towpath. Turn right heading away from the bridge. Continue on the towpath passing a second Bridge 46 and turn off at Bridge 45. You are now back at the Tearooms.
